AMENDMENT TOREPORT OF THE BOARDFINDINGS AND ORDER

1. Hearing Date and Place: This matter came on for hearing before the Virginia Gas and Oil Board (hereafter "Board") at 9:00 a.m. on August 18, 1992, Dickenson Conference Room, Southwest Virginia Education 4-H Center, Abingdon, Virginia. At said hearing, the Board granted the relief sought by the Applicant and pooled the interests in Pilgrims Knob Gas Field Unit PKE-26 pursuant to § 45.1-361.21, Code of Virginia, for the production of conventional natural gas, and the Board entered its Order pertaining to same on October 1, 1992, recorded October 8, 1992 at Deed Book 399, Page 478, in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Buchanan County, Virginia, VGOB Docket No. 92-0818-0247 (herein "Board's Order"). Contrary to the evidence presented at the hearing of this matter, the Board's Order inadvertently states that the estimated and allowable production over the life of the proposed well to be 80 mcf/d and the estimated amount of reserves contained within the unit to be 0.58 bcf. At Applicant's request, this amendment to the Report of the Board, Findings and Order, is being entered and recorded with the Clerk's Office of Buchanan County to conform the findings contained in Paragraph 17.7 of the Board's Orders to the evidence presented at the hearing on August 18, 1992 and the Board's findings pertaining to same.

2. Findings:

2.1 The Board has heretofore entered its Order more particularly described in Paragraph 1 above.

2.2 Paragraph 17.7 of the Board's Order states that the estimated and allowable production over the life of Proposed Well PKE-26 is 80 mcf/d and the estimated amount of reserves contained within the unit is 0.58 bcf.

2.3 The Applicant's uncontroverted evidence at the hearing established that: "the estimated average production for the well over its life is 80 mcf/d. The estimated amount of reserves contained within the unit is 0.58 bcf. These figures concerning estimated production and the amount of reserves are, however, estimates only that are not based upon actual production."

3. Conclusion: Paragraph 17.7 of the Board's Order is amended to conform to the Board's Order to the uncontroverted evidence presented at the hearing of this matter by deleting said Paragraph 17.7 in toto and replacing it with the following language:

17.7 The estimated average production for the well over its life is 80 mcf/d. The estimated amount of reserves

contained within the Unit is 0.58 bcf. These figures concerning estimated production and the amount of reserves are, however, estimates only that are not based upon actual reserves.

4. Mailing of Order and Filing of Affidavit: Applicant or its Attorney shall file an affidavit with the Secretary of the Board within ten (10) days after the date of receipt of this Order stating that a true and correct copy of same was mailed within seven (7) days from the date of receipt of this Order to each person pooled by the Board's Order whose address is known.

5. Effective Date: This Order shall be effective on the date of its execution.
