REPORT OF THE BOARD

FINDINGS AND ORDER

1. **Hearing Date and Place:** This matter came on for final hearing before the Virginia Gas and Oil Board (herein "Board") on May 15, 2007 at the Southwest Virginia Higher Education Center on the campus of Virginia Highlands Community College, Abingdon, VA.
2. **Appearances:** Jack Fletcher and Tom Fletcher appeared *pro se* for Applicants; James E. Kaiser, Esq. Appeared for the unit operator, and Deanis Simmons, Assistant Attorney General, was present to advise the Board.
3. **Jurisdiction and Notice:** Pursuant to Va. Code §§ 45.1-361.1 *et seq.*, and in particular Va. Code §§ 45.1-361.21 and 45.1-361.22, the Board finds that it has jurisdiction over the establishment and maintenance of an escrow account, with tract subaccounts, for each of the coalbed methane gas drilling units established by the Board through its field rules that are subject to a Board pooling order. Further, the Unit Operator is required to deposit, as applicable, those funds specified in Va. Code § 45.1-361.21.D., 45.1-361.22.A.2, 45.1-361.22.A.3 and 45.1-361.22.A.4 into the applicable escrow tract subaccounts. The Board finds that: (1) while it does not have jurisdiction to resolve conflicting claims to the ownership of the Coalbed Methane Gas produced by the Unit Operator from wells located on Subject Drilling Unit, and (2) while it does not have jurisdiction to interpret agreements by and between the Gas owners/claimants and/or the Unit

Operators or to abridge or contravene the provisions of such agreements, (3) pursuant to Va. Code § 45.1-361.22.A.5, the Board does have jurisdiction and authority to disburse funds from the Escrow Account provided the Board has been provided with a final decision of a court of competent jurisdiction adjudicating the ownership of coalbed methane gas as between the conflicting claimants or an agreement among all claimants owning conflicting estates in the tract in question or any undivided interest therein.

4. **Prior Proceedings:**

- 4.1. On October 1, 2002, the Board executed its order pooling all interests in the Subject Drilling Unit for the production of occluded natural gas produced from coalbeds and rock strata associated therewith (herein "Gas") in accordance with the provisions of Va. Code §§ 45.1-361.21 and 45.1-361.22 (herein "Pooling Order"). The Pooling Order was filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Buchanan County on October 2, 2002 in Deed Book 555 at page 571. The Board designated Equitable Production Company as the Unit Operator of the Subject Drilling Unit. The Pooling Order was amended and supplemented by the Board's Supplemental Order regarding elections executed on February 18, 2003 that was filed with the Dickenson County Circuit Court Clerk's Office on February 21, 2003 in Deed Book 563 at page 239 ("Supplemental Order"). (Hereafter the Pooling Order and the Supplemental Order are collectively referred to as the Pooling Orders).
- 4.2. To the extent claims to the Gas were in conflict, pursuant to Va. Code § 45.1-361-22 payments attributable to said conflicting claims/interests were ordered deposited by the Unit Operator into the escrow account established by the Pooling Order (herein "Escrow Account"). According to the Pooling Order, the coalbed methane ownership of Pine Mountain Oil and Gas, Inc. and the oil and gas fee ownership of Applicants or their predecessors in title in a 4.39-acre tract known as VGOB Tract 2 in Subject Drilling Unit VC-505187 were in conflict and became subject to the escrow requirements of the Pooling Order. Applicants elected to participate in the well working interest partners.
- 4.3. The Petitioners' Miscellaneous Petition for the release of escrowed funds dated March 16, 2007, a copy of which is attached to and made a part hereof, and sworn testimony attested that the Unit Operator, Pine Mountain Oil and Gas, Inc. and Applicants have executed a Stipulation of Interest Letter Agreement defining each party's working interest and interest in the escrowed funds attributable to Tract 2 of the subject Drilling Unit, and therefore escrow regarding the conflicting claims of said parties is no longer required.
- 4.4. The Unit Operator notified Pine Mountain Oil and Gas and the Applicants that its Miscellaneous Petition requested that the Board consider: (1) entering an Order to release the escrow funds attributable to Tract 2 and the interests of Applicants being held by the Escrow Agent; and (2) delete the requirement that the Unit Operator place future proceeds attributable to the above-named parties in Tract 2 in the Escrow Account.
- 4.5. The Unit Operator filed the attached accountings for Subject Drilling Unit's Escrow Account with the Board ("Accountings").

5. **Findings:**

- 5.1. Va. Code 45.1-361.22.5 provides:

The Board shall order payment of principal and accrued interests, less escrow account fees, from the escrow account to conflicting claimants within thirty days of receipt of notification of (i) a final decision of a court of competent jurisdiction adjudicating the ownership of coalbed methane gas as between them or (ii) an agreement among all claimants owning conflicting estates in the tract in question or any undivided interest therein. The amount to be paid to the conflicting claimants shall be determined based on the percentage of ownership interest of the conflicting claimants as shown in the operator's supplemental filing made part of the pooling order that established the escrow account, the operator's records of deposits attributable to those tracts for which funds are being requested, and the records of the escrow account for the coalbed methane gas drilling unit. The interests of any cotenants who have not entered into an agreement shall remain in the escrow account.

5.2 The Petitioners have certified and represented to the Board that:

- (1) Applicants are the owners of 100% of the oil and gas estate underlying 4.39 net acres of VGOB Tract 2 of the subject Drilling Unit.
- (2) Applicants elected to participate as working interest partners in the Subject Drilling Unit.
- (3) The Unit Operator, Pine Mountain Oil and Gas, Inc., and Applicants have entered into a Stipulation of Interests agreement defining working interests in the Subject Unit. By the agreement, all conflicting claims regarding coalbed methane ownership in the Subject Unit are resolved, and Applicants are to receive equal shares of escrowed funds.
- (4) The net interests attributable and to be disbursed to Applicants in Tract 2 are shown in Table 1, below.

6. **Relief Granted:**

For the reasons set forth in Paragraphs 4 and 5 above, and based upon the Accounting, the Escrow Agent is ordered to, within 10 days of receipt of this executed order: (1) Disburse 100 per cent of the funds attributable to VGOB Tract 2, being 100 per cent of the funds on deposit in the escrow subaccount on the date of disbursement, as follows: 11.1111 percent of escrowed funds to Tommie A. and Carol Fletcher; 11.1111 percent of escrowed funds to Clair Fletcher; 11.1111 percent of escrowed funds to D. Marie Fletcher; 11.1111 percent of escrowed funds to Helen Blanche and Virgil Boyd; 11.1111 percent of escrowed funds to Emily and William C. Wood; 11.1111 percent of escrowed funds to Bea Fletcher; 11.1111 percent of escrowed funds to

Estate of Paul Kinsey C/o Ryan McKillips, Executor; 11.1111 percent of escrowed funds to Harless E. Fletcher; 11.1111 percent of escrowed funds to Jack and Betty Fletcher; and mail attributable proceeds to the addresses shown in the table.

Exhibits to the Pooling Order, showing owners subject to escrow, are deleted in toto. Further, the Supplemental Order filed in this cause is hereby modified to delete the requirement that payments attributable to the oil and gas fee ownership of Applicants in Tract 2 be deposited by the Unit Operator into the Escrow Account, and, because there are no other owners subject to escrow under the Supplemental Order, the Escrow Agent is directed to close the Escrow Account for Subject Drilling Unit. To the extent not specifically granted herein, any other or further relief is denied.

7. **Conclusion:**


Therefore, the requested relief and all terms and provisions set forth above in Paragraph 6 above be and hereby are granted and IT IS SO ORDERED.

8. **Appeals:**

Appeals of this Order are governed by the provisions of Va. Code § 45.1-361.9 which provides that any order or decision of the Board may be appealed to the appropriate circuit court and that whenever a coal owner, coal operator, gas owner, gas operator, or operator of a gas storage field certificated by the State Corporation Commission is a party in such action, the court shall hear such appeal de novo.

9. **Effective Date:** This Order shall be effective on the date of its execution.



2. Facts:
 - a. Equitable was designated as the Operator and Applicants interests were Pooled in the VC-505187 Unit by Order of the Virginia Gas and Oil Board (hereinafter "Board") executed on October 1, 2002, pursuant to Docket No. VGOB 02/06/18-1035 and recorded in the Circuit Court Clerk's Office of Buchanan County, Virginia on October 9, 2002, Deed Book 555, Page 571 (hereinafter "Order").
 - b. The order and Supplemental Order required the Escrow Agent named and appointed therein to establish an interest-bearing escrow account for funds pertaining to the above-referenced Unit and subject to escrow pursuant to the terms of the Order.
 - c. The Order and Supplemental Order further required the Operator to deposit bonus and royalty payments with the Escrow agent which could not be made because the person(s) entitled hereto could not be made certain due to conflicting claims of ownership.
 - d. Pine Mountain Oil and Gas, Inc. was a conflicting claimant with the above-listed Plaintiffs with regard to Tract 2.
 - e. To resolve this conflict, a Letter dated November 22, 2006 signed by Jerry H. Grantham, an officer of Pine Mountain Oil and Gas, Inc. is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".
 - f. The amounts deposited with the Escrow Agent regarding the Unit need to be determined and distributed accordingly.
 - g. Any escrow amount, not yet deposited into the escrow account, held by Operator should also be determined, and distributed to Applicants/Plaintiffs herein, accordingly.
 - h. Applicants/Plaintiffs herein do hereby request that the Board enter amended supplemental order for the Unit directing the Escrow Agent and the Operator to disburse to the aforesaid Plaintiff the funds attributable to the previous conflicting claim with Pine Mountain, held in escrow for the VGOB number as listed above.
 1. The Applicants certify that the matters set forth in the application, to the best of their knowledge, information, and belief, are true and correct and that the form and content of the Application and conform to the requirements of relevant Board regulations and orders.
 2. Legal Authority: Va. Code Ann. §45.1-361.1 et seq., 4 VAC 25-160, and such other regulations and Board orders promulgated pursuant to law.
 3. Relief Sought: Applicants request that the Board issue amended supplement order amending all prior orders affecting the Unit which amended supplement order will provide as follows:
 - a. Determining the amount of funds attributable to the Applicants/Plaintiffs herein.
 - b. Directing the Escrow Agent to determine the amount of funds attributable to Applicants/Plaintiffs herein, provide an accounting hereof, and disburse the funds on deposit with the Escrow Agent, including any applicable interest, pertaining to the interest in the Unit shown above for distribution.

- c. Directing the Operator to determine the amount of funds attributable to the Applicants/Plaintiffs herein, provide an accounting thereof, and disburse the units in its hands, if any, subject to escrow but not then on deposit with the Escrow Agent, including any applicable interest, at the time of the Supplemental Order requested therein is executed, attributable to the Applicants/Plaintiffs herein for distribution.
- d. Directing the Operator to disburse the funds, including any applicable interest, and provide an accounting thereof, which it may receive after the date of the execution of the amended supplemental order requested in the Application, if any, attributable to the Applicants/Plaintiff herein, and to discontinue the payment of such funds into Escrow.
- e. Granting such other relief as is merited by the evidence and is just and equitable whether or not such relief has been specifically requested herein.



As you know, Equitable Production Company (EPC) had proposed, as operator, well VC-505187 which is located in Buchanan County, Virginia. The referenced well was subject to the above referenced VGOB Order granting EPC the right to proceed with the drilling of the well, and providing the interest owners certain elections to make as to their participation or the leasing of their interest in the well and its associated unit.

Included in the Well Unit for VC-505187 is a tract of 4.39 acres which had a conflicting claim related to the ownership of coalbed methane gas. In accordance with the Order of Virginia Gas and Oil Board for Forced Pooling of Interest in a Drilling Unit Encompassing Well Number VC-505187, EPC was notified that certain oil and gas owners had elected to take Option 1 - "To Participate in the Development and Operation of the Drilling Unit".
