REPORT OF BOARD

FINDINGS AND ORDER

1. This Supplemental Order is entered by the Board sua sponte in the form authorized by the Board at its hearing held at 9:00 a.m. on October 20, 1992, Board of Supervisors Room, Courthouse, Grundy, Virginia, and pursuant to authority granted to the Board's Chairman at the hearing of the Virginia Gas and Oil Board on June 16, 1992, at 9:00 a.m. at the Rhododendron Restaurant at the Breaks Interstate Park, Breaks, Virginia; and this Supplemental Order is being recorded for the purpose of (1) complying with the requirement of the Virginia Gas and Oil Board Regulations, 4 VAC 25-160.70C by supplementing the Order previously issued by the Board for subject Docket on October 8, 2007 and recorded in Deed Book 444, Page 695 in the Office of the Clerk of Circuit Court, Dickenson County, Virginia on November 1, 2007, (herein "Board Order") to complete the record regarding elections. The Board Order pooled all interest in Subject Drilling Unit including those of the Respondents more particularly set forth and identified by the Designated Operator in the affidavits attached hereto and made a part hereof. The Board finds it has jurisdiction over the subject matter pursuant to the provisions of the Virginia Gas and Oil Act, § 45.1-361.1 et seq., Virginia Code, 1950 as amended.
2. Findings: The Board finds that:
 - (a) The Board Order directed Equitable Production Company, (herein the Designated Operator"), to mail copies of the Board Order to all respondents whose interest, if any, were pooled by said Board Order;
 - (b) The designated operator filed its affidavit of mailing dated November 19, 2007, disclosing that it had mailed a correct copy of the Board's Order to all Respondents whose interest, if any, were pooled by said Board Order;

- (c) The Board Order required each Respondent whose interest, if any, were pooled by the terms of said Board Order to make his or her election within thirty (30) days after the date of mailing or recording, as applicable, of said Order; the Designated Operator has filed its affidavit dated October 23, 2008, in accordance with § 7.C of the Virginia Gas and Oil Board Regulations and 4 VAC 25-160.70C (herein "Affidavit of Election"), wherein it has, for each Respondent whose interest, if any, were pooled by said Board Order, stated: (i) whether each Respondent has made or failed to make a timely election; (ii) the nature of the election made, if any; (iii) whether, by reason of a failure to elect or to timely elect one or more Respondents are deemed, under the terms of the Board's Order, to have leased all their rights, title, interest, estates and claims in Subject Drilling Unit to the Designated Operator;
 - (d) The Board Order further required the Designated Operator, after expiration of the election period, to file with the Board a statement of the interests subject to escrow under the terms and provisions of the Board Order, in light of the elections made or deemed to have been made (herein "Statement of Interests"); that the Designated Operator furnished said Statement of Interests as part of its Affidavit of Election. A copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit B;
 - (e) Current Board standards requiring the escrow of funds and the Board's agreement with its Escrow Agent, Wachovia Bank, N.A., VA7515, P.O. Box 14061, Roanoke, VA 24038, (540) 563-7764, Attn: Judy Barger, or any successor named by the Board, require the entry of a Supplemental Order establishing of record the elections made or deemed to have been made and specifying the sums or percentage thereof subject to escrow. Current Board escrow standards were made applicable to Subject Drilling Unit by a Board Order dated December 23, 1992.
3. Order: By this Order, the Board orders the Designated Operator to tender, consistent with and in accordance with the findings set forth at paragraph 2 above and the annexed Affidavits, any funds subject to escrow and instructs the Escrow Agent, Wachovia Bank, N.A., VA7515, P.O. Box 14061, Roanoke, VA 24038, (540) 563-7764, Attn: Judy Barger, or any successor named by the Board to establish interest-bearing escrow account(s), IRS Tax Identification Number 54-1629506, in accordance with the information set forth in said affidavits to receive such funds and account to the Board therefore.
4. Mailing of Order and Filing of Affidavit: The Designated Operator under the captioned Order or its Attorney shall file an affidavit with the Secretary of the Board within ten (10) days after the date of receipt of this Order stating that a true and correct copy of this Order was mailed to each person whose interest or claim is subject to escrow and whose address is known.
5. Conclusion: Therefore, the findings and all terms and provisions set forth above be and hereby are granted and IT IS SO ORDERED.





DGO / OMIS VGOB project – September 29, 2010 meeting

(jal / revised 09/30/2010)

Attended by: David S., Matt S., Diane D, and Jim L. Daniel K. and Lacey M. reported in by e-mail in the Lebanon DMME office.

September 29, 2010 agenda.

1.) DGO progress with the VGOB file data collection process,

DGO has completed approximately 95% of the original 815 escrow files with data entered on the spreadsheet. Work is progressing and on schedule. All of this data will need to be migrated to SQL. There are approximately 200 new orders added that will need to be processed in. This is a dynamic number that will be added to each month. Once the data entry screens are up and running, DGO will enter the data there to add directly to the SQL database.

Action Items:

Diane and Jim will test out the SQL data entry screens to test and make corrections / improvements. If up and running ok, DGO will shut down the MS Excel data entry process (at the end of the week?) and begin entering all data in the new system.

Note that ongoing data maintenance for continuing VGOB actions will be necessary. This will need to be assigned.

2.) Status of the SQL database, data entry screens, and data migration from Excel to SQL.

Matt S. has completed the first versions of the SQL database, escrow calculator with buttons to the index map and scanned pdf docket files, and data entry screens. Test and live versions of the escrow calculator and data entry screens went up on the DMME Intranet 9/28/2010. Links were provided to Diane and Jim 9/29/2010 for testing and review. Both were quickly reviewed during the meeting. Minor corrections and changes were noted, and some additional programming to complete the projects will be needed.

Migration from Excel to SQL continues to be a challenge. Students will transfer the data collected by DGO on the Excel spreadsheets to the SQL database cut and paste style. \$1000 funding for this has been secured.

Action Items:

David and Matt made a list of needed corrections and will work on them as money is available. As noted above, Diane and Jim will test out and offer other corrections or modifications as discovered.

Matt S. is out of money and hours – although more work on the database, data entry screens, data migration from excel to sql, and the google earth / gas unit grid map remain. David S. will try to estimate additional time needed and send a cost estimate to DGO for further funding.

3.) Migration of Dynaterm data (legal fields, recording dates, deed book pages, etc.) to eliminate duplication,

Matt S. has programmed the data entry screens to link and self populate entries from Dynaterm in as many fields as he could find. As identified today, some additional work and fine tuning (adding link to field name, etc.) will be needed.

Action Items:

As Diane and Jim test the data entry screens and begin to enter data, they will look for other common fields from Dynaterm that can be automatically populated – and make recommendations as needed.

As stated above, Matt S. is out of money and hours – although more work on the database, data entry screens, data migration from excel to sql, and work on the google earth / gas unit grid map remains. David S. will try to estimate additional time needed and send this estimate and request to DGO.

4.) Status of the spatial database / GIS “Gas Unit” map (and links to the table data being collected),

Daniel could not attend, but sent an update on the GIS database creation and virtual map. To date 457 gas units have been added to the geodatabase. Unit Number, Docket Number and Unit Operator are the 3 key attribute fields being verified. These will eventually tie to SQL database using the Docket Number. Action Items:

Working with Daniel, Brent Hughes has taken the lead in building the geodatabase for the gas units – which is then sent on to Matt S. to develop the map service for customers. Daniel pointed out this work will continue and will need to be maintained as new units are added.

Matt S. will be developing the overlay of the gas units from the GIS group with Google Maps to create a Web Map Service; and link the map and scanned board order documents to the citizen escrow calculator. (Funding and hours for Matt remain in question.)

Protocol to merge bank records, ongoing maintenance, .tiff scans to OCR PDF images, the need to establish a comprehensive Virginia Gas Unit grid map, and storage all remain needed items as we progress.

5.) Status of .tiff to .pdf scans of the VGOB files for the citizen calculator and DMME archiving (OCR update?),

Lacey could not attend, but sent an update on the scanning and ocr / pdf progress. She has scanned 192 to the original 825 files, averaging about 45 per week. Files are becoming thicker, and this number most likely will fluctuate. OCR programs are being tested and should be determined very soon – to transform .pdf for the web service. [In addition, master file format, file naming, and chain-of-custody inventory issues were resolved over the past month. These projects appear to be progressing well and on schedule – ja]

Action Items:

Scanning work will continue (estimated ~10 to 15 more weeks?), and questions / problems resolved as they come up.

A decision for an OCR choice is needed to migrate to .pdf format and make available on line.

6.) A better handle on the end product reports (DGO role / OMIS role / and financial calculations), for

- **Virginia Treasury report (abandoned property and funds within the Escrow Account)**

Action Items:

It was discussed that needs to be worked on as a combined DGO / OMIS effort. Most likely this will include a simple spreadsheet report format for the Treasury and a DGO Disbursement format for the VGOB. It was recommended that once data has been successfully migrated into the SQL database – Jim, David S. and David A. will work to define needed data fields and report format templates (most likely in late October or November).

- **Web-based citizen calculator / “virtual map” / link to docket file**

A live version of this, using information plugged into the acreage in escrow and acreage in escrow owned manually by a citizen is ready to go – if we want to put it on the internet. Bank and financial calculations have been completed and are working, but regularly updated (monthly?) information will be needed. The virtual unit map and scanned VGOB dockets are being worked on. Programming is complete to link total acreage in escrow (SQL), bank data (Bank), the map (GIS), and scanned dockets (.pdf scanning project) to the web page interface – as data sets becomes available. The FAQ's need to be completed.

Action Items:

FAQ's and instructions need to be completed. Location of this task and responsibility for this task is currently not clear.

Status and timing of when it is desired for this to go live on the internet is not clear. Once FAQ's are completed, should the calculator go live to allow data fields entered by users ... or wait until other data (total acreage in escrow, map, and dockets) are available? Clarification is requested.

- **Well production and escrow deposit monitoring / audit tool.**

As reported in August, OMIS will take care of this. DGO will assist as needed and requested.

7.) Server space for storage and web delivery of the database, citizen calculator, interactive “virtual map”, and .pdf docket files – regarding possible VITA charges and funding sources?

Although not reported out during the meeting – Todd R. estimated that approximately 20GB of storage space would be needed for the VGOB project and web delivery and this would cost approximately \$55 per month in an e-mail dated September 02, 2010.
