
Electric vehicle chargers installed at VCU

electric vehicle charging

Two charging stations are on the second floor of the

parking deck and two more in the north deck on the MCV campus.

At 240 volts, the L2 EV charging stations can charge a vehicle in one to four hours — up to three times faster than an L1 charging station. VCU is the first university campus in the state to acquire the L2 charging stations.
