



**PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ENTER  
TO CONDUCT RECLAMATION ACTIVITIES**

(Abandoned Mine Land Program)

IN THE MATTER OF: **HOBBS BRANCH PROJECT**

**TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:**

The Department of Mines, Minerals, and Energy, Division of Mined Land Reclamation, of the Commonwealth of Virginia, pursuant to the authority granted in the Virginia Coal Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1979 (Chapter 19, Article 4, Section 45.1-260 et seq.) with funding provided by the **2012** Consolidated Grant, has determined and found that:

Land located **1.5 miles southeast of the intersection of Route 83 and Route 728 on Hobbs Branch** in **Buchanan** County, Virginia, has been adversely affected by past coal mining practices, to wit:

1. Property owners, both known and unknown, are hereby notified of the Division's intention to reclaim the area adversely affected by past coal mining practices. The purpose of this Notice is to provide notice to any landowners, heirs, assigns and devisees who may be affected by the proposed reclamation and who have not been identified and who have not granted written consent.
2. The public health, safety and property is endangered by: **mine drainage and unstable surface mine outcrops above occupied residences.**
3. The proposed action consists of:
  - a) Constructing access roads as needed;
  - b) Construction and installation of structures to convey drainage to the stream channel;
  - c) Stabilizing surface mine overburden material by constructing a retaining wall;
  - d) Revegetation of all areas disturbed by this work. Approved revegetation mixtures will be used.
  - e) Standard erosion and sediment control measures will be implemented throughout this project.

Based upon the above findings, the Commonwealth of Virginia, acting by and through the Department of Mines, Minerals and Energy, Division of Mined Land Reclamation, its agents, employees and contractors, gives notice that 30 days from this Notice being published in **The Grundy Mountaineer**, and posted on the property, the Division will initiate and continue until the proposed work on **Hobbs Branch Project** is complete, and shall do all things necessary and expedient to protect the public health, safety and general welfare. Such entry shall not be construed as an act of condemnation of property nor of trespass thereon.
