Frequently asked questions:

Q: How can the governor receive future messages by email instead of fax?

A: Please send an email to steven.biel@signon.org with the preferred email address and staff contact information. Your email address and contact information will NOT be visible online or made available to the public.

Q: Why should the governor receive messages by email instead of fax?

A: SignOn's online system makes it easy to manage correspondence with your constituents who create or sign petitions. Via email, you can respond to the petition creator, to individual messages, and/or to all constituents at once.

Q: How many emails will the governor receive?

A: Switching from fax delivery to email will not increase or decrease the number of communications you receive from SignOn.org. SignOn.org limits the number of faxes or emails that are sent per day and per week. The governor will only receive messages from constituents.
